Serra Real Connections is a part of SAY (Social Advocated for Youth) San Diego, which is a useful resource that has been on Serra’s campus, and schools all around San Diego County for over twenty years. SAY San Diego provides various programs and/or services (tentatively shown below) on-campus and off-campus and all free of service to students located on the campus of Serra High School.

**Services & Programs:**

- One-on-One Mentoring** (focused on attendance, academics & goal-setting)
  - Tutoring Services** (at lunch and/or after school)
- After School groups focused on Professional Development, Basic Skills and/or Enrichment Activities**
  - Male or Female Groups Focused on Positive Decision Making Skills and Behaviors**  
*Please note: these groups occur after school from 2:30-3:30pm*
  - Referrals to Outside Support Agencies**
- FREE household Items, bedding, toys, baby care items, furniture, and clothing**

All of the above services are voluntary and may be offered to your son/daughter. **Please check the boxes for all services you give permission for your student to be involved in should they be offered him/her.** This slip must be signed (accepting services) and sent back to Ms. Eernisse-Liang @ Serra High School (office box or through fax). You may also hand this over to your school counselor.
